Through this exciting partnership the [Saskatchewan Playwrights Centre \(SPC\)](#) offers membership and available services to all active members of the Saskatchewan Drama Association (SDA) including students and teachers. These services would include access to dramaturgical support, workshops and classes, entry into SPC events, and access to SPC's script library, as well as any new services SPC may offer in the future. The partnership also include voting rights at the SPC annual general meeting to active adult members of SDA. All high school and university students and teachers will be able to submit works to the SPC for dramaturgy and receive the support of the dramaturgical committee as long as they are active with the SDA. Younger students would access through their teachers. This includes any work submitted to the SPC outside of the school channels (e.g. a SDA active student or teacher may submit their work independently). If the author(s) are interested in pursuing support, they have access to the full power of the SPC, up to and including the SPC advocating for them to professional theatres and publishing houses.
